

## TEACHING POSITION ENGLISH

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Université de Technologie de Compiègne (UTC) is recruiting an English teacher for its Humanities and Technology Department.

### Context

Université de Technologie de Compiègne (UTC), a member of the Sorbonne University Alliance (ASU) and the network of universities of technology (UT), is ranked among the top French engineering schools by a number of national league tables, and offers a particularly favorable environment for teaching and research.

The TSH department is concerned with the context in which today's engineers operate. The technological and socioeconomic spheres form an indivisible whole, and the work of engineers necessarily has an ethical and political dimension. TSH seeks to develop and communicate (1) techniques and research paradigms that shed light on this connectedness - TSH is an interdisciplinary department that brings together expertise in a variety of domains including cognitive science, information and communication science, economics, management, philosophy, and sociology; and (2) procedures and tools for engineers navigating this interconnected reality (for example, relating to the management of innovative projects, and the design of interactive interfaces).

### Job Description

Our Languages Section, which proposes eight languages to UTC students, at levels ranging from A1 to C2 in the European Common Reference Framework, is recruiting an English teacher. We are a team of approximately fifty teachers, both permanent and freelance, and we enrol and teach roughly 2000 students each semester in our language classes. The person hired will teach both students enrolled in the EDHEC/UTC bachelor program (Digital Engineering and Management) and our classical engineering courses.

The teacher we hire will be responsible for running a course module, with the associated pedagogical and administrative tasks, and for adapting existing content. He or she will also teach several other course modules (British Civilisation, as well as some of the course modules in our apprenticeship section). An aptitude for team work is essential.

### Profile

We are looking for a dynamic teacher with a strong sense of responsibility and commitment to teamwork, as well as excellent organisational skills. Minimum qualification level: Masters degree and / or proven teaching experience in higher education establishments (experience with student engineers particularly appreciated). Applicants should be bilingual (French / English), be familiar with word-processing and spreadsheet software, and have experience of working with online teaching platforms such as Moodle.
